Explore their vivid social and architectural history through personal accounts, anecdotes and historic photographs, and discover 12 decades of cinemagoing history around the world.

Marc Zimmermann is the Chairman of the Cinema Heritage Group (CHG), an NGO founded in Dublin in 2006 and dedicated to the recording and preservation of cinemagoing history worldwide, whose work he will introduce at this talk.
